



## “LANCASTER GARDEN TOUR”

*June Each Year*

Lancaster is known for its scenic countryside — and is actually known as “*the Garden Spot of the World.*” This tour focuses on Lancaster’s beautiful countryside and some of the loveliest gardens in the area.

At the heart of the tour is the *annual Demuth Garden Tour*. You’ll visit the Demuth Museum, a property dedicated to the artwork and legacy of Charles Demuth, a master watercolorist whose home and the inspiration for much of his work was Lancaster. Many of Charles Demuth’s floral watercolors were inspired by his mother’s gardens. During the Demuth Garden Tour, you’ll visit several private homes and gardens, where you’ll find much to inspire your own home and garden planning. The guided Demuth Garden Tour will also include a lecture and/or live demonstration involving gardening at the Conestoga House. This site features over five acres of gardens, where you’ll see a distinct European influence evidenced in the number of urns and flowering window boxes throughout the gardens.

This tour package will include a visit to Longwood Gardens, the world’s premier horticultural showplace. Here you’ll find over 1,000 acres of natural woodlands, majestic gardens, breathtaking conservatories, and dancing fountains.
