One day or overnight tour

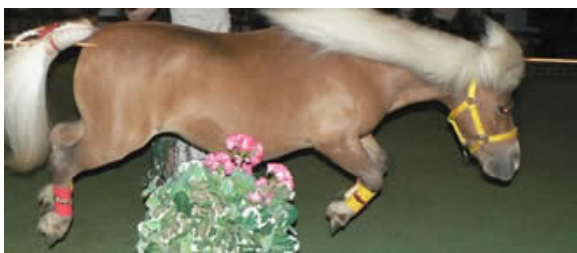
