

Annual Memorial Illumination Antietam Battlefield

1st Saturday & Sunday in December

Antietam National Battlefield was the scene of the bloodiest one-day battle in American History. It brought to an end General Lee's first northern invasion. Tonight, commemorate those who fought in this heroic battle with a **candlelight Memorial Illumination** ~ 23,000 glowing candles – one for each soldier killed, missing or wounded at Antietam.



Before the display, spend some time in nearby Hagerstown as you tour the:

Miller House ~ In the entrance hall is the original hanging stairway rising in a graceful curve to the third floor. A wonderful clock collection and an exquisite assortment of antique dolls will also be on display.

Round House ~ Depicts the history of the Western Maryland Railroad and six other railroads that made Hagerstown the “Hub City”.

Before departing for the Battlefield, dinner is included at a **local restaurant**
