Three Days/Two Nights

Set out on a holiday-time journey to Lenox, Massachusetts and the beautiful Berkshire Mountains. Visit the **Norman Rockwell Museum** to see many of the illustrator’s works in the original oil paintings at your own pace. Your home for two nights is an authentic New England inn, located in the heart of the Berkshire Mountains. **Dinner** is included at the Inn this evening.

Following your **continental breakfast**, journey to Pittsfield and the **Berkshire Museum Festival of Trees** where you will view more than two hundred trees of all sizes on display. Each special tree is individually and exquisitely decorated for the holidays. The Christmas trees are displayed throughout the galleries. The Berkshires are known as the “Inland Newport” and display mansions built during the turn of the century before the days of income tax. Therefore, we have included a **Berkshire Cottages driving tour** to allow you to view the exteriors of the fine homes of Andrew Carnegie, Harley Proctor of Proctor and Gamble Co., George Westinghouse, the Vanderbilts and many others who formed the American Aristocracy. Your guide will relate stories about these colorful characters and explore the era of the “Gilded Age”.

**Lunch is included today at the famous Red Lion Inn**, started in 1773 as a stagecoach stop between Boston and Albany, N.Y. After lunch, you will be given some time at the **Yankee Candle Factory** where it’s always Christmastime at the Bavarian Christmas Village. Your adventure continues in the Black Forest on to the Village Square past the waterfall beside the moat over the drawbridge to the Nutcracker Castle



The highlight tonight is **Bright Nights Holiday Light Display** set in Springfield’s historic 750-acre Forest Park, a perfect backdrop for the more than 500,000 twinkling lights. Springfield was the birthplace of the author of Dr. Seuss books. You will marvel as you drive past dozens of holiday scenes. The two and a half mile drive turns us all into children again. **Dinner** this evening is included at a local restaurant.

Following your **continental breakfast** on the third day, you will check out and begin your journey home, making a stop in Hartford to **tour the Mark Twain house**, decorated for the holidays.
