



VICTORIAN CAPE MAY CHRISTMAS

SINGLE OR MULTI-DAY TOUR

Ever since the 1860's, Cape May has been one of the most popular seaside resorts in America. It was the vacation spot of choice for the rich and the famous in the 1800's and its turn of the century Victorian splendor is unmatched. Today we celebrate the turn of another century, yet Cape May still captivates visitors with its Victorian grandeur. This entire community is on the National Register of Historic Places. It is certainly a trip down memory lane.

Upon arrival in Cape May tour the lavishly restored 1879 Physick Estate giving you a glimpse into the lifestyle of the rich and famous of the American Victorian era. Next is a trolley tour of Cape May's Historic District. Relax on the cheery "Victorian Trolley" as your guide points out the highlights of the gingerbread trimmed Victorian architecture as well as tales of Cape May's history. Enjoy browsing the colorful shops of the Washington street Mall and adjoining Carpenter's Lane and Congress Hall. Lunch is on your own at one of the many fine eateries. Meet your guide for a walking tour of 3 of Cape May's Victorian Mansions, all located within a four-five block area. Take a peek into the past at the artfully restored Victorian inns, grand ladies all bedecked in gingerbread and carpenters lace.

Late afternoon check in to your lovely oceanfront room at the Atlas Inn. Enjoy a walk by the ocean before your included dinner at the Washington Inn, one of Cape May's landmark restaurants in an elegantly restored plantation house. Following dinner depart for the Grand Hotel for a Christmas Show.

The day begins with a hot included breakfast in the sunny oceanfront dining room of the Atlas. Following breakfast is a guided tour of Cape May Point, the southernmost tip of New Jersey. Listen as your guide relates a bit of local lore and points out the 1859 Cape May Point Lighthouse, lake Lily and the USS Atlantus, partially submerged off Sunset Beach. Next board the coach and depart for Renault Winery for a tour and wine tasting. A family-style dinner is included with music and dancing. A brief stop at the Town of Historic Smithville will complete the day. Stroll the cobblestone paths and enjoy the multitude of rustic shops and attractions
