Leaf Peeping and Five Train Rides in West Virginia

Discover “Wild and Wonderful” West Virginia by train and discover the scenic beauty and natural wonders. Travel into the mountains, valleys and highlands of West Virginia’s most unique wilderness. Travel through the Tygart Valley to the High Falls of the Cheat River, visit the Greenbrier River Valley, and travel the logging trails of the Cass Railroad into the high timber of West Virginia. Board the Potomac Eagle in Romney, WV and enjoy a scenic ride along the Potomac River and watch for Bald Eagles!

Ride aboard the following trains:

New Tygart Flyer – Welcome aboard the smooth riding, mountain climbing New Tygart Flyer excursion train for a journey deep into the Cheat Mountain Wilderness. This comfortable train is climate controlled and features large windows and private reclining seats, a dinette serving snacks, sandwiches, and beverages and the Flyer’s own edition of the Rail & Trail Store.



The Durbin Rocket – Visit the old-fashioned town of Durbin located in the sheltered valley of the Greenbrier River and hear the echo of the whistle from steam-powered Climax #3 of the steep mountainsides. Antique steam locomotives are always a treat to see and hear, each with their own unmistakable personalities, you will see, hear and ride aboard the Durbin Rocket!



Cass Scenic Railroad – Nestled in the mountains of West Virginia, Cass Scenic Railroad State Park offers excursions that transport you back in time and let you re-live an era when steam-driven locomotives were an essential part of everyday life. Trips to Cass are filled with rich histories of the past and unparalleled views of a vast wilderness area.

A ride on **the Cheat Mountain Salamander** is a larger-than-life wilderness adventure. The lofty heights of Cheat Mountain harbor one of the largest unspoiled wilderness areas in the entire Appalachian region. Sightings of bear, bobcat, fox, osprey and other rarely seen wild animals are common on the route of the Salamander—a route that takes you into the heart of this pristine mountain wonderland.



Potomac Eagle - The historic Potomac Eagle Scenic Railroad is one of America's most beautiful train rides. For three hours enjoy a narrated excursion through a tranquil and pristine mountain valley. View historic farms and lush mountain greenery. Around every curve you are rewarded



with the splendor of native wildflowers, evergreens, and mixed hardwoods in an unspoiled countryside environment. Experience “The Trough,” a spectacular narrow mountain valley. The water on the South Branch of the Potomac River is so clear that you can see fish as they lie resting in the shade. You will enter a sacred place, the eastern home of our magnificent national symbol, the American Bald Eagle. These majestic birds soar high above in their natural habitat, undisturbed by the low rumblings of the occasional train and the passengers who have come for a sighting.

Tour package includes three nights lodging, room tax, three dinners, two lunches, three breakfasts, five train rides as outlined above, visit to Pearl Buck Home Museum, visit and tour at National Radio Observatory, escorted while in WV, escort gratuity, round trip motor coach transportation and bus driver gratuity.
