

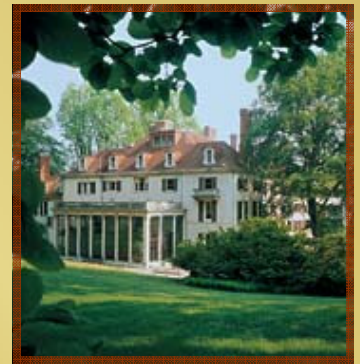
Lunch & Private Tour of **BRANDYWINE RIVER MUSEUM** with Victoria Wyeth

Join your friends and members for a visit to the **Brandywine River Museum**. Often called the “Wyeth Museum” for its extensive collection of works by the internationally acclaimed Wyeth family – grandfather N.C., father Andrew and son Jamie – the Brandywine River Museum is housed in a converted 19th-century grist mill on the banks of the Brandywine in Chadds Ford, PA. Enjoy a **specialty arranged private tour of the museum with Victoria Wyeth**, the only grandchild of artist Andrew Wyeth. She will lead you on a tour of her grandfather Andrew Wyeth and her Uncle Jamie Wyeth’s art works on exhibit at the Museum.



Ms. Wyeth will then join you for an **included lunch at the Chadds Ford Tavern**. After lunch you can return to the Brandywine Museum to explore other exhibits featuring works by Brandywine school founder Howard Pyle and students including Maxfield Parrish, as well as paintings by American Illustrators Charles Dana Gibson, Rockwell Kent and others.

Or, consider some of the other **options for the afternoon**: a visit to nearby Longwood Gardens for free time and/or a special behind-the-scenes tour, a specially arranged tour at Winterthur or the Hagley Museum.
