



## *“A Lighthouse, A Dam and Lunch on the Bay”*

Port Deposit and Havre de Grace

Imagine one of the narrowest towns in the world. Come to **Port Deposit**, Maryland, and we will show it to you. This unique town with its distinctive Port Deposit Granite buildings is located between the Susquehanna River and a 352-foot wall of solid granite—one street wide!

Once the most active trading city on the Upper Bay, **Port Deposit** is approximately five miles downstream of one of the largest hydroelectric dams in the East: **Conowingo Dam**. We will visit its basin on this tour (if security is lifted) followed by a visit to the **Paw Paw Museum** to get a special look at Port Deposit as it was many years ago.

**Lunch at McGregor’s** (on the Bay) in Havre de Grace is next on the itinerary. Following lunch we will begin our look at **Havre de Grace** with a visit to the **Concord Point Lighthouse**, and the world famous **Decoy Museum**. As we head for Union



Avenue with its Victorian Houses and nearby shops of Washington Street, we will have a special stop at **Bomboy’s**—the home of some of the **best hand-made candy & ice cream** in the world.
