

# *A Literary Journey:*

James A. Michener's Chesapeake Tour



Meet your local guide in Cambridge, MD and then board the **Cambridge Lady** for a narrated cruise based on Michener's experiences while writing his novel, Chesapeake.

Dock in Oxford and enjoy **lunch at the historic Robert Morris Inn**, dating back to 1710 and one of the oldest historic inns in the United States. Here author James Michener declared he had the "best crab cakes on the Eastern Shore."

Then decide on one of the following options:

1. Join your guide from the Oxford Historic Society for a walking tour of this quaint village. One of the oldest towns in Maryland, Oxford was one of only two ports of entry on the Chesapeake Bay during Colonial times; OR
2. Take a break and enjoy the view. Sit under a tree on the "Strand", the premier waterfront overlooking the Tred Avon River. James Michener rated this river as the number one river on the Eastern Shore in his novel; OR
3. Stroll the village shops looking for a souvenir of your Eastern Shore visit.

After you visit in Oxford, you re-board the Cambridge Lady for your return cruise and then continue homeward.
