



# ***Pubs, Prohibition & Piety***

Take a stroll with a **Historic Lancaster Walking Tour guide** to revisit **Lancaster at the time of the Prohibition** and learn how prohibition affected life in our fair city. Hear about the Lancaster breweries that at one time gave Lancaster the title of “**Munich of the West**”.



Learn about the mysterious vaults where beer was made and distributed to speak easies. Learn how the crooked judge on the Lancaster bench helped bootleggers get off scot-free.

Visit **St. James Episcopal Church** and learn how one of the past rectors and other upstanding citizens and businessmen organized the Law and Order Society to “clean up” Lancaster, and learn how our very own local “Eliot Ness” eliminated bootleggers, the mob, and the crooked police force in less than a year.

On the Piety side of the tour you will tour **Holy Trinity Church**. Holy Trinity Church is the spiritual heir of over two and one-half centuries of Christian witness in the Colony and Commonwealth of Pennsylvania. Originating a half-century before the Declaration of Independence, the congregation is the oldest in Lancaster and one of the oldest in Pennsylvania. The beautiful sanctuary stands today as one of America's front line colonial churches, historically and architecturally.
