

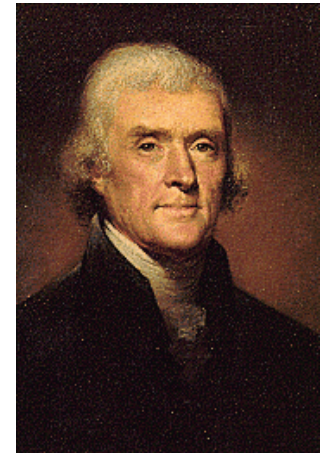


Journey with the Presidents

Take an adventure and rediscover the origins of our great leaders. Visit their childhood homes, the communities where they grew up and where they began their political trail to greatness. This educational trip is fun and hands on and is sure to keep all who attends engaged in learning (including the teachers)!

- **Visit Ferry Farm** in Fredericksburg, Virginia where **George Washington** lived from age 6-19
- **Walk** around the **George Washington's Birthplace Monument**
- **Tour Colonial Williamsburg** including the **Governor's Palace** and the **Capital** (3 hour guided tour)
- **Participate** in a **Scaventures** activity. This is a scavenger hunt through out the historic section where the group is divided into teams, given and list of items to find and a Polaroid camera to document their finding. Very exciting and the students learn a lot.
- **See Mount Vernon**, the home of **George Washington** for over 45 years
- **Visit William and Mary College** where **Thomas Jefferson** began his political career
- **Stop** at the **State Capital of Virginia** which was designed **Thomas Jefferson**
- **Explore Monticello**, the former home of **Thomas Jefferson**
- **Participate** in the "Before They Were Presidents" or "The Constitution" programs at **Presidents Park**. These are hands on activities lead by an interpretive guide
