

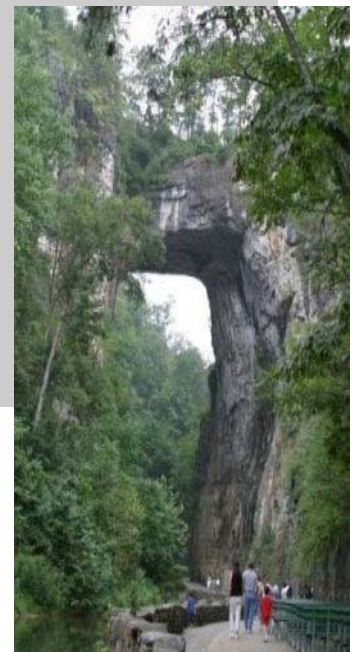

Have an **Apple Pickin'** Good Time in the **Shenandoah Valley**

Day 1

Arrive in Lynchburg for a tour of historic **Old City Cemetery**. Following this tour you will head to your hotel to check in then it's off to cocktails, dinner and Jazz at the **Norvell-Otey House**. This historic 1817 federal mansion is the oldest structure in Lynchburg serving as a bed and breakfast. Authentically restored and furnished with period antiques and accessories, it reflects the elegant lifestyle of the wealthy founders and builders of the city, almost two centuries ago. This home is the largest and finest period federal mansion in the Federal Hill Historic District.

Day 2

Enjoy a full breakfast in your hotel prior to your departure to Lexington. Here you will take a charming **carriage ride** through the historic streets of this college town. Next you will tour the home of Thomas Jonathan Jackson better known as "**Stonewall**" **Jackson**, the Confederate General. This afternoon you head to one of the 7 natural wonders of the world, the Natural Bridge. With the **Caverns, Wax Museum, Toy Museum, Monacan Indian Living History Village Walking Trail** and the **Natural Bridge** itself, there is something for everyone here. Tonight you will enjoy the **Drama of Creation** where you will see the Natural Bridge all lit up with musical accompaniment is added to form a moving drama of creation.



Day 3

Following a full breakfast, you will head to Charlottesville. Here you will visit **Ash-Lawn Highland**, former home to James Monroe and his wife Elizabeth Kortwright Monroe. This home was bequeathed to the College of William and Mary, Monroe's alma mater. Lunch will be at **Michie Tavern** where they have been welcoming guests for over 200 years. This is where your 18th-century counterpart came to dine and socialize. You will experience the Tavern's past through an historical journey which recreates life when Mr. Michie operated his Inn. This afternoon you will head to **Monticello**, home of Thomas Jefferson. Monticello is the autobiographical masterpiece of Thomas Jefferson, designed and redesigned and built and rebuilt for more than forty years. Dinner tonight will be on your own in charming Charlottesville.



Day 4

Enjoy a full breakfast in the hotel prior to departure to the **Peaks of Otter Orchard and Winery**. This unique winery features "Fruit of the Farm" wines made from a wide variety of fruits apples, grapes, blackberries, blueberries, peaches, chili peppers, cherries, figs, elderberries, beets and much more all grown here on the farm located in the foothills of the Blue Ridge Mountains at the foot of the Peaks of Otter. Next it is off to the National D-Day Memorial, lunch at Old Liberty Station and your departure home.
